## Reminders

- Please remember to call in your students if they are going to be absent. You can always leave a message at the 998-0459 phone number.
- Now that the weather is starting to change please make sure your child is still coming to school in uniform. You can review the uniform policy in your Parent & Student Handbook.
- Students are marked tardy in their classroom after 7:45am. After 8am an adult needs to walk them into the office and sign them in. If your child has 5 unexcused tardies they will lose a recess. 10 unexcused tardies your child will lose a full day of recess. 15 unexcused tardies will result in a referral made to the District Attorney's office for educational neglect.
- Students are only allowed 5 unexcused early dismissals a school year. There are no early dismissals after 3pm.
- Since the cold and flu season is right around the corner DO NOT send medication with your child. An adult needs to bring the medication in and fill out the necessary paperwork with Jolene, Health Assistant. Students should never have any type of medication on them. An adult needs to pick up the medication.
- We are starting to see sweaters & jackets laying on the playground and left in the cafeteria. Please write your child's name in their jacket so we know who it belongs to and it can be returned.
- Please be patient when you are dropping off or picking up your child. Look out for kids crossing the street, obey the speed limit and most importantly please be courteous to our officers and teachers who are on duty. They are out there to keep all our children safe.
