## 2017-2018 School Year Information

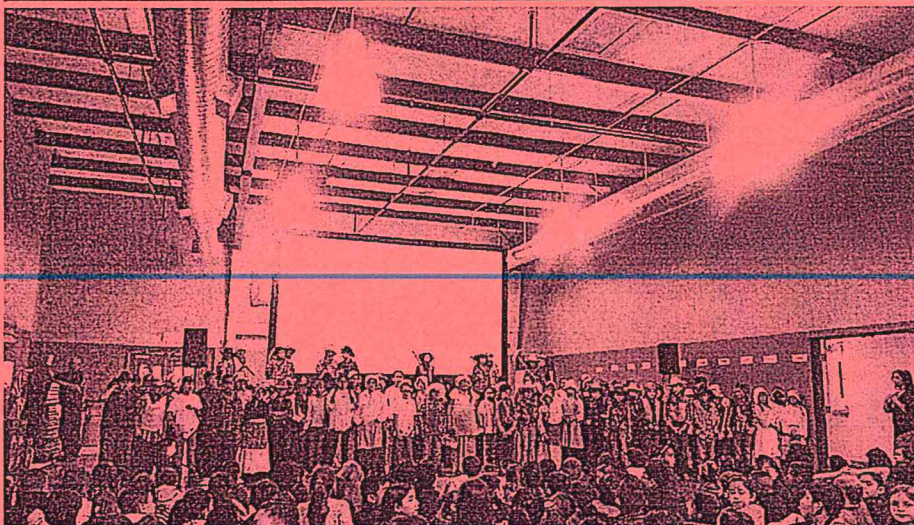
